OFHA 6209 reports visit of SHCHERBAKOV to Finland in late June 1963 in which he described himself as auxistant deputy to SEMICHASTNYY during talks with former Finnish Military Attache in Moscow, POYHONEN. - full report available in the dispatch chrono)

Extract from paragraph 6 which describes topic of conversation between SHCHERBAKOV and POYHONEN:

*After some further discussions of military purchases, SHCHERBAKOV turned to another subject, American intelligence activities in Finland. Among his charges were: . . .

e. He declared that the Americans with the help of KLIMOV, the Soviet defector, had tried to mess up a good Soviet-Finnish relationship. (Probably a reference to a visit made by Ambassador Gufler and ROODINE to see President KEKKONEN in January 1962 in which Gufler, on instructions from Washington, charged that the Soviet Note to Finland in October 1961 was engineered with the knowledge of the Finns.

Holder 1961 was engineers.
