POR ACTS OF TERRORISM, SABOTAGE AND THE ATTIMETED ASSA SINATION OF COMANDANTE FUEL CA TRO AND OTHER RETRIBUTATIVES OF THE SE-VOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT., FRUSTEATED BY THE VIGILANCE OF THE FEOPLE AND SELECTION OF SELECTION OF SELECTION.

The self-atyled counter-revolutionary organisation "covimiento Pevoluci nario del Euchlo" ("CR.P.) was created about the middle of 1960 by "anuel Ray Ritard with the object of fighting the Cuban Levolution. Turing the tyranny Ray aspired to overthrow the relime of Entiata but to leave intact the rule of Imperialism and of the oligarchy which served it in our country. The "R.F. is a counter-revolutionary organisation whose members are drawn mainly from the well-to-do middle class, among them professional geomete, senior employees, midalists elements of the telephone, electricity and bank workers' unions and also disaddents and traitors from the 26th of July Tevolutionary Tovement.

Department of Utate, but when the United Utates broke off relations with the U.I.A. took over the frection of the counter-revolution. The failure of Playa Girón and the consequent arrest of counter-revolutionary elements caused these groups of traitors to become demoralised and disorientated and their position was made worse by the orisis in the J.L.A. itself which ended with the dismissal of Plan Pulles and other officials. The Yankee Government proposes to use against Guba certain Central American flovernments such as Justemala, Ricaragua, Resta Rica, etc. and in this connexion there have taken place recently meetings between the commanders and officials of the forces of these countries and a meeting of American Ambass-adors presided over by Testor cowles.

With the object of creating in Tube an internal situation for trade to the acrossive plans which they are preparing, the C.I.A. save precise instructions to the leaders of the T.a.L. for them to put into practice a vast plan of terrorist acts which began in deptember, and which, in accordance with the plans of the C.I.A. was to culminate with an attempt on the life of the trime Minister. The plan of sabotage suggested by the C.I.A. was considered by the Estional Coordinator of the V.R.T. and other counter-revolutionary. leaders who decided that it would be executed by the Military Operations Section, with the assistance of the workers' Courdinators. The plan envisaged a series of acts of substage on September 29 in the nationalised stores fin de Siglo, J. Valles, Sears, and the restaurant of the "Capri" hotel. All these were to take place before the assassination attempt. The substage of Fin de Siglo was directed by recato Amador del Rio, eline "millo", Provincial Lorkers' Coordinator of the ..... who was to give two incentiary bombs to Uaria de los Angeles Abach Lib, the secretary of Actorio Teynold Gonzalez. The was to place them in the store but the vicilance of the people prevented this act of sabotage from being committed. Roth were arrested. The person in charge of the sabotage of the J. Valles store was Antonio Veciana ("Victor") or "Carlos"), who succedded in escaping to the United States. Veciana cave two incendiary tombs to a certain aul who is said to belong to the Unbotage Dection of "Rescate", and who is closely connected with Vectora. The mave them to a couple who have not yet been identified but here again the vigilance of the people prevented the ambotage from being committed. Vectors was also in charge of the substage in the Notel Capri and have two inceptiary bombs to dought Alzugaray, as employee in the restaurant, who is at present under arrest and who said that he was not able to place the bombs. On hearing that at, the Finca Hurra, situated in El Morado on the road between Jainy and Ilcano, the property of andor Odio and his wife Sara del forro, ous icious meetings had been taking place, an investigation was carried out which showed that this fince was frequently vinited by member of the diplomatic corpo accredited in Havana and particularly by the charge d'Affaires of Venezuela, Seffor Zurbaran and the Charge d'Affaime of Colombia. It was also face found that the finca was visited by Antonio Reynold. Gonzalez and his wife Teresita Alvarez, who is at present abroad, and also by Maria de los Anceles Abach Dib, who acted as a link with Embassies and who placed the incendiary bomte in Fin de Jiglo. On July 13 sixteen diplomatic representatives of various Latin American countries visited this fince, not including any from Brazil, Sexico and Scuador. These dislomate held a meeting with Amador Odio and Gara del Torro witch lasted over two hours. They remained in the finca until 1 a.m. and the last to leave was the wife of the They remained in Chargo d'Affaires of Colombia, who took with her in her car a large quantity of meat and lard for counter-revolutionaries in asylum. On one occasion the Charge d'Affaires of Venezuela took Antonio Reynold Conzalez and M. abach Dib to his Embassy in order that Maria might speak to her brother, Laurdo, who was in asylum (he used to be the producer of the television programme "ann and God"). At the same time deynold Gonzalez had discussions with other asyless.

Reynold Conzalez, who recently carried out an act of sabotage in the warehouses of La Rayonera at Luyano, was arrested at the Finca Hurra. M. Habach Bib was the teacher of the children of the Chargé d'Affaires of Colombia. Another diplomatiwhe visited the Chargé d'Affaires of Colombia. Another diplomatiwhe visited the finca was Elvira Zayss, the hargé d'Affaires of Fanama. Señor Colombia wife, who had been supplying the counter-revolutionaries in asylum in various embassies, were arrested. Frier to April 17, the date of the invasion, the embassy with which the V.L.P. had the closest contact was that of Venezuela, Fiter the invasion the H.R.P. continued to remain in touch with the Venezuelan Chargé d'Affaires who introduced the Colombian and Tanamanian Chargés d'Affaires. The M.R.F. gave \$1,000 a month to the Venezuelan Embassy for the maintenance of the asyless and also paid for the passasses of those who left the country. The Venezuelan Embassy served all the counter-revolutionary groups, accepted an excessive number of asyless, took into its charge papers and possessions and permitted asyless to go out of the Embassy and return.

The Embassy of Italy has also served counter-revolutionary groups, permitting such leaders as Repin Fernandez Eadus to stay in its residence, and also taking available the diplomatic bag for the correspondence of these organisations. On one occasion the diplomatic bag was used by the J.R.F. to bring from Mismi a report from Ignacio J. de Mendoza "Rufino". It was also used to bring in money for the M.P.C., M.R.R., Unidad etc.

There follows a long list of persons arrested and weapons discovered in various parts of Havana and neighbouring towns.

For two months the leaders of the M.R.P. had carefully sale planned an assessination attempt against Commandants wisel Castro and other leaders of the Revolutionary Severnment but this plan was frustrated by the vigilance of the people and the opertune intervention of the Department of State Security.

The plan was aperoved by the Workers' Coordinators of the M.R.P. of a meeting which took place at the office of the Entional Commission for Alphabetization, situated in the former Escuela del Rogar, the plotters pretending to be alphabetizers. The office was made available by Sector R. Lopez Fernandez (now under arrest) and by the woman in charge of the biulding whose name was Fitzgibbons who also provided them with alphabetization manuals in order that the dissimulation might be complete. The plan was made known to Rufino, the C.I.A., the State Department and to Miro Cardons.

The bazocka was to be fired from a window of the apartment at the platform installed on the north terrace of the Presidential Palace at dusk. After firing the bazocka the plotters were to throw fragmentation grenades in order to cause panic and so that they might in the confusion take flight dressed in militia and army uniforms and armed with their automatic was wanpons.

The Department of State Security with the assistance of the vigilance of the people has thus not only succeeded in frustrating the criminal acts of sabotage and attempted assassination which had been planned but has also almost totally destroyed the counter-revolutionary organisation of traitors and enemies of the people, directed by the C.I.A., which called itself Movimiento Sevolucionario del Pueblo.
