1. During the March PJKARAY in \_\_\_\_\_ the ZRAFAID delegation led by LIQUIFER/T (L-7), asked for the PJKARAY to program a \_\_\_\_\_ to be held in Mexico. L-7 argued, quite well, that such a Seminar would be politically useful to L-7's organization both nationally and internationally because the publicity which could be generated around such an event would cast the ZRAFAID in a very favorable light. In line with NEPTIC's policy of strengthening ZRAFAID's national and international prestige NEPTIC Agents in the PJKARAY supported ZRAFAID's request and the PJKARAY subsequently approved the program.
2. Following the PJKARAY, L-7 made two or three attempts to get WSAACROAT to implement the program for a regional seminar including the participation of the SOPIAET organizations from Central America. NEPTIC Case Officers declined to approve the Central American regional initiative because of the expected participation of a member of anarchist led DIPLAINS. NEPTIC Agents were instructed to seek ZRAFAID's agreement to a national seminar which would include individual participants from two or three different countries. In September, during his trip to JIMENEZ meeting, L-7 and ZRAFAID president-elect, agreed to the national seminar with individuals from other countries participating. At Headquarters' request, implementation of the seminar was held up by NEPTIC Agents in WSAACROAT in order to avoid impeding NSX's establishment of contact with the new ZRAFAID's president.
3. NEPTIC Agents in WSAACROAT would now like to move ahead in the implementation of the seminar before the end of the year because of other program commitments following January and have submitted a plan to Headquarters for coordination. The plan has been forwarded to NSX under separate Cover.
4. The Seminar is scheduled from December 12-22nd. Please cable Station comments with info copy to PJP.
