1. 30 DEC ANPALM-5 ASKED [redacted] IF HE DID NOT AGREE THAT  
MOMENT TOO CRITICAL AMPLIFY ANPORT, SUGGESTING BROAD REPRESENTATION  
COULD BE ACHIEVED LATER IN PROVISIONAL

2. [redacted] REFERRED ANPALM-5 10 MONTHS OF DISCUSSION THIS  
SUBJECT PLUS 19 DEC MTG WITH BENDER WHEN ENLARGEMENT APPARENTLY  
AGREED ON. SAID ON CONTRARY THAT MOMENT MORE PROPITIOUS  
THAN EVER, STARTING WITH ELECTION MANUEL CIBO TO FILL SEAT LEFT  
VACANT BY ANEER. ANPALM-5 ACCEPTED VIEW JOYLESSLY.

3. COMMENTS: VIEW QUERY AS TRIUMPH BALLOON BY ANJAG WHO AS

ANY OTHER FIGURE. AMPALM-5 [REDACTED] SAID HE WISHED  
TABLE 'A' PECULIAR CANDIDATE AND [REDACTED] ARCHBISHOP BOZA.  
[REDACTED] DOUBTED THAT CUBAN TRADITION WAS SUSCEPTIBLE SUCH  
FUSION CHURCH AND STATE BUT AMPALM-5 SUGGESTED WEAKLY THAT  
BOZA AS PRIVATE CITIZEN COULD SERVE.
