REACTOR RELATIONS

1. ON 6 DECEMBER 1966, FIDEL CASTRO RIZ, PRIME MINISTER OF CUBA,  
SENT A PERSONAL MESSAGE THROUGH HIS ACCREDITED AMBASSADORS TO THE  
FOREIGN MINISTRIES OF MEXICO AND BRAZIL. THE MESSAGE ASKED THE  
MEXICAN AND BRAZILIAN GOVERNMENTS TO TAKE THE INITIATIVE BY FINDING  
SOME MEANS OF RE-INTEGRATING CUBA INTO THE FAMILY OF LATIN AMERICAN  
NATIONS. CASTRO INDICATED THAT HE BASED HIS REQUEST ON A REPORT,  
WHICH HE BELIEVED TO BE TRUE, TO THE EFFECT THAT THE UNITED STATES  
GOVERNMENT WAS SOFTENING ITS DIPLOMATIC LINE TOWARD CUBA, AND WAS  
CONSIDERING A RESUMPTION OF MORE NORMAL RELATIONS WITH CUBA IN THE
