There is enclosed herewith an article which appeared in the 11/2/64 edition of the "Legal Intelligencer," a publication of the Philadelphia Bar Association.

The author of the article, VINCENT J. SALANDRIA has two addresses, 2226 Delancey Place and 1805 South 18th Street, Philadelphia.

Philadelphia indices reflect that VINCENT SALANDRIA, Esq., 1916 South 15th Street, was the addressee of a mailing of approximately 1,000 letters sent out by the Citizens Against Rearming Germany in March 1952. This was a temporary propaganda organization substantially infiltrated by the CP.

In April 1963, XPH 61-Sxturned over a list captioned (W "Additional List for Mailings to Meetings and Subs," which was used in connection with a fund raising affair 3/29/63 sponsored by the Independent Citizens Committee for Political Action. The name VINCENT SALANDRIA, 2226 Delancey Street. appeared on the list. The Independent Citizens Committee is a political action group comprising many innocent non-Communists but having substantial Communist direction 157-916-363 from the too.
