United States. Subject ATKINSON, who is in the Goldsboro, N. C., area at the present time, is expected to contact SUTTON in the near future to ascertain if he has made the purchase of the identification cards. ATKINSON will take the cards to Bangkok with him if obtained by SUTTON. SUTTON is expected to take the cards to Bangkok himself if he cannot obtain them by the time ATKINSON returns. SUTTON has been advised to stall ATKINSON when contacted by him. He will tell ATKINSON that he probably can buy the cards, but not for at least a month. SUTTON has not made any attempt to make such a purchase. SUTTON is agreeable to travel and will help the Bureau in any way possible.

Charlotte indices are negative for ATKINSON and JACKSON.

Upon furnishing the attached LHM to military agencies or other agencies, the Bureau is requested to advise them to protect the information in the LHM, as to reveal it in total when interviewing subjects would surely reveal his identity to those individuals.

Charlotte desires to be advised of the results of information developed by the military in order that the veracity of the informant will be evaluated and to determine whether there are any possible prosecuteable violations within continental jurisdiction.

From the information set forth it appears that most, if not all, of the potential illegal operations are in Saigon and Bangkok, Thailand; therefore, appropriate dissemination of the LHM should be made to agencies having an interest in these locations.
