ADMINISTRATIVE:

The lead which was set forth in referenced report to reinterview Mrs. ELMO HOLLOMAN, 5603 Jackson Street, Alexandria, La., was not covered inasmuch as subsequent to the last interview of Mrs. HOLLOMAN on 10/22/64, she wrote a letter to the Director in which she indicated she was angry about being contacted by the FBI. In her letter to the Director, Mrs. HOLLOMAN stated she joined the "MINUTEMEN" to see "what they were up to." She indicated that for the same reason she subscribed to "The Worker". Mrs. HOLLOMAN stated that she had not carried out a single assignment given by the "MINUTEMEN" not because there was anything at all wrong with this organization but simply because she did not have the time. She did indicate that she was a "chapter leader" in the John Birch Society, which she considered the "proudest assignment of my life." Even though Mrs. HOLLOMAN expressed confidence in the Director, it is felt that nothing worthwhile would be accomplished by a reinterview.
