Lord Hall, 20, is the son of the late Lord Hall of Birkenhead, a Conservative MP from 1951 to 1966. Hall attended many secret meetings in London and elsewhere in 1967, and is believed to have been present until his resignation and departure from the Conservative Party in 1968. Hall is currently in the United States, where he was in Berkeley, Calif., on Nov. 22, 1963, the day President Kennedy was killed.

He charged the FBI with a conspiracy to assassinate Kennedy. He has told Carlson that of the meetings, which were attended by members of the Central Intelligence Agency, plans were made to kill President Kennedy, Robert Kennedy, Martin Luther King, and other international figures. He has given Carlson a list of names, dates and places.

He also, presumably for reasons of the CIA, has given Carlson a copy that the CIA has...
