Subject: Cover Issues Names

A search of the State Department diplomatic list revealed information regarding the posting assignments of the following individuals.

Dewey Clarridge

Clarridge states in his book [A Spy for All Seasons](#) that he was a case officer stationed in New Dehli from 1960-1962, and Chief of Base in Madras from 1962-1964. The State Department diplomatic list reports that Clarridge was an assistant attache in the consular section of the U.S. Embassy in New Dehli beginning on 6 April 1960, and was vice consul in Madras beginning on 16 September 1962. Clarridge was still listed as vice consul in the October 1964 publication of the diplomatic list.

Alan White

The State Department reports that White was a political officer in the U.S. Embassy in Mexico City beginning on 23 May 1963. As of the September 1967 publication of the diplomatic list, White was still listed as a political officer with the embassy.

E. Howard Hunt

In his deposition before the HSCA (Part II, p. 8), Hunt states that he was a CIA employee in Mexico from December 1950 to March 1953. The diplomatic list reports that Hunt was an attache stationed in the U.S. Embassy in Mexico City beginning on 13 December 1950. Hunt's name did not appear in the April 1953 publication of the diplomatic list.
