We request your assistance in obtaining access to information and records of possible pertinence to the John F. Kennedy assassination. We request that you locate and provide the annual or biannual Station reports for the Mexico City Station for 1963 and 1964. In requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them "assassination" records and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.

This request should be interpreted in the broadest reasonable sense. To the extent that you question whether a particular record is encompassed by our request, please let us know and we can advise you whether we seek to include it.

We request that you make this information available to us by February 3, 1997. If this does not provide you with sufficient time, please let us know, in writing, by what date you believe you will be able to respond to this request.
