Pursuant to its authority under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, the Assassination Records Review Board requests the following:

- 1. Access to all 201 files, personnel files, Office of Security files, P-files, or any other files related to David Sanchez Morales.
- 2. Access to all 201 files, personnel files, Office of Security files, P-files, or any other records relating to Ted Shackley relating to his service at the JMWAVE station between 1962 and 1964.
- 3. Access to all 201 files, personnel files, Office of Security files, P-files, and any other files relating to Ron Cross, Bart Henry, and Doug Gupton related to their service at the JMWAVE station. It should be noted that these names are pseudonyms, used by CIA personnel who testified to the HSCA.

This request should be interpreted in its broadest possible sense. To the extent that you question whether a particular file or record is encompassed by our request, please let us know and we can advise you whether we seek to include it.

Should this request impose an unreasonable burden on you that we may not have anticipated, please advise us so that we can work with you to modify or amend the request accordingly.

In requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them "assassination records" and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.
