Dear John:

As Mary and I discussed with Barry late last Friday, CIA's long-awaited response to ARRB's request for evidence about the true names to be considered at tomorrow's Board meeting was disappointing and inadequate. For several months, the Board has been encouraged by the CIA to expect a comprehensive presentation of specific evidence relating to its desire to protect the true names of CIA employees. The Board has delayed action on hundreds of assassination records in anticipation of this evidence. We are frankly concerned not only by the impact the CIA's action will have on our work, but also by the fact that we feel we have been misled by the Agency in this instance.

We urge your full compliance with our request in time for tomorrow's meeting.
