

NOTICE OF ASSASSINATION RECORD DETERMINATION

Designation: The following United States Secret Service materials are designated assassination records: USSS correspondence with members of the Warren Commission (1964); selected documents from the “protective research” file (1962-1964); and the document “Briefing Book: Director’s Appearance Before the House Select Committee on Assassinations, December 1978.”

Discussion: On June 4, 1996, by unanimous vote, the Assassination Records Review Board designated the above listed materials as assassination records pursuant to Section 7(i)(2)(A) and 9(c)(1)(A) of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act (“the JFK Act”) and § 1400.1 and §1400.8 of the Guidance for Interpretation and Implementation of the JFK Act. 36 C.F.R. § 1400 (1995). In not designating some records from the “protective research” file as assassination records, the Review Board relied upon the advice of its staff, which conducted a thorough review of materials in the above listed categories.
