In accordance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, I am writing to inform you that the Assassination Records Review Board has made additional formal determinations concerning the public disclosure of JCS records at its meeting on August 25, 1997.

Enclosed is a list of the determinations that the Review Board has made. Records from the JCS Collection begin with the prefix "202." These decisions were based on several factors including the historical interest in the documents and the absence of evidence that the release of the information would cause harm to the United States or to any individual.

You have seven days to appeal these decisions to the President. You are invited to send your representative to the Review Board's offices to examine our copies of the documents for which determinations have been made and to discuss the determinations with my staff.
