Dear Mr. Bowron:

On August 6, 1996, the Review Board designated the following United States Secret Service materials as "assassination records" pursuant to Section 7(i)(2)(A) and 9(c)(1)(A) of the JFK Act and to Sections 1400.1 and 1400.8 of the Guidance for Interpretation and Implementation of the JFK Act, 36 C.F.R. § 1400 (1995): Protective survey reports for planned Presidential trips to Philadelphia; Elkton, Maryland; New York; Palm Beach; Cape Canaveral; Miami; Tampa; and San Antonio in the October 31, 1963-November 21, 1963 period; and a thirteen-minute radio interview (on tape cassette) with Chief James Rowley on August 7, 1963.

I have separately sent today a more detailed explanation of the Review Board's designations to Ms. Jane E. Vezeris of the Office of Administration.
