Dear Jane:

This letter constitutes our second formal request for additional information and records under The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994).

We request that you make available to us all photographs, audiotapes, films, and videotapes in the possession, custody, or control of the Secret Service that are reasonably related to the Kennedy assassination. This request includes, but is not limited to, films of the Parkland doctors' news conference on November 22, 1963; any photographs, recordings, or film footage of Lee Harvey Oswald; any recording (and/or transcript of a recording) of Secret Service or military communications created on tape (or any other recording device) of the Dallas motorcade; and any communications between the Secret Service and the National Photograph Interpretation Center regarding any photographs or films depicting the assassination.

To the extent that this request presents logistical or other difficulties that we may not have anticipated, or to the extent that these records may be located in the National Archives at a place other than in the JFK Collection, we will be happy to discuss with you ways in which the request might be amended.
