Thank you for your letter of April 15, 1996 to Mr. David Marwell regarding certain referred assassination records. Mr. Marwell asked me to respond to you.

Records which are referred to other agencies will eventually be reviewed by the Board, if the relevant agencies seek to have information postponed. If the agencies do not seek to have information postponed, the records will go directly to the National Archives and will become part of the JFK Collection. I cannot tell you what the time frame will be on these particular documents because they are still in the possession of other agencies. I will provide copies of your letter to appropriate staff members. I will advise you if I learn anything about the status of these documents.

Again, thank you for your letter and your continuing interest in the work of the Review Board.
