This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 6, 1995, which was received at the Review Board offices on January 5, 1996.

First, your appeal under The Freedom of Information Act is acknowledged and will be processed consistent with the Act and the relevant Review Board regulations.

Second, per your request, I have enclosed the five FBI documents relating to the Swiss Government's assistance to the Bureau in locating Lee Harvey Oswald prior to the assassination. These documents are provided without charge as a courtesy of the Review Board.
