Dear Dr. Foregger:

This is in response to your letter of August 12, 1996 to Chairman Tunheim regarding the work of Professor Guinn for the House Select Committee on Assassinations. Chairman Tunheim asked me to respond to your letter.

As you know from our conversations, the Board and staff are aware of your interest in the work of Professor Guinn. Additional work is continuing on this matter. The Review Board has received thousands of suggestions, leads and requests. We are attempting to process them as effectively as possible. With a budget for only a small staff, there are many different projects related to the pursuit of assassination records that are ongoing, all at the same time. As you are aware, although you first wrote to Chairman Tunheim in December 1993, the Board was not sworn in until April 1994, did not have any staff besides the Executive Director until October 1994, and was not fully staffed until early 1995.

Thank you for your continuing interest in the work of the Review Board. We will advise you when there is information to share on this matter.
