Thank you for your fax of October 23, 1996. Per your request, I have enclosed a copy of FBI document number 124-10144-10086.

Unfortunately, we do not have the resources to provide summaries of each document that is released by the Board. The agencies that possess assassination records enter information about its own materials into an electronic index system. The National Archives and Records Administration maintains this system and has set up a site on the Internet where you can access this information. I have enclosed information about the Archives Internet site.

The National Archives does not have a similar information packet simply because our tasks are different. The Review Board releases the records, and the National Archives preserves them and provides copies to the public. The Archives does not issue press releases as often as the Review Board, which along with press clippings, make up a large portion of the material in our packet. We do include a brochure from the National Archives in our packet about the JFK Collection, and I have enclosed one in the event you have not seen it.
