Dear Mr. Haller:

This is in response to your letter of July 9, 1996 regarding the Buell Wesley Frazier polygraph test.

Our preliminary review of the existing records did not indicate that the polygraph test of Frazier is in the JFK Collection. A search of the record showed several documents dealing with the Frazier polygraph test, but none of them say where it is located. As a courtesy to you, I have enclosed a letter from the Dallas Police to the HSCA stating that they do not have it, an outside contact report from the HSCA files indicating that the National Archives does not have it, and a letter from HSCA Chief Counsel G. Robert Blakey requesting it from the Department of Justice. We did not find a response from the Department of Justice to the Blakey letter. However, we did find a memo from the FBI to the Department of Justice that makes reference to the HSCA request but not does specifically state whether or not they have specific knowledge of the whereabouts of the polygraph test.

Please advise us if you have any specific additional knowledge relative to the Frazier polygraph test that would assist us.

Thank you for writing and for your interest in the work of the Review Board.
