Re: Donation of Records

I called your office yesterday to advise you of the following:

1. The records which you and your family so kindly donated to the JFK Collection have been processed by an archivist and will be made available to the public at the National Archives next Tuesday, April 9th.
2. Laura Denk, an attorney with our staff, told me that she was awaiting the return of the deed of gift. If that is ready, we would appreciate receiving it to ensure that the paperwork is complete.
3. In looking through the papers which you donated, I expected to find statements from the so-called "Clinton witnesses," but they were not there. I am not sure how much you know about the records, but several people from Clinton, Louisiana allegedly saw Oswald there with Shaw and Ferrie in the late summer or early fall of 1963. Gerald Posner focused on these statements (and discredits them) in his book. He said the statements were in your father's papers (see the attached excerpt from Case Closed). Any light you can shed on the situation would be much appreciated. It would be helpful if you could give me a call at (202) 724-0088, ext. 227.
