Dear Mr. Marshall:

Several weeks ago, I left a voice mail message for you at the station. Since I did not hear back from you, I would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the Assassination Records Review Board, the independent federal agency overseeing the identification, review and public release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The Review Board's primary responsibility is to review assassination records held by federal agencies and make them publicly available in The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection, which is housed at the National Archives facility in College Park, Maryland. In addition, the Congress gave the Review Board the authority to determine if there are relevant records, films or photographs in private hands that are relevant to the assassination.

The Review Board received information from a private researcher that KFDX may have film footage from the day that President Kennedy was assassinated. I would appreciate the opportunity to discuss this possibility with you in the near future.
