RAND in Moscow, USSR. In this cablegram RAND stated he was to meet with the subject in company with (FNU) SCHNEIDER, U. S. Diplomatic Representative in Moscow on 10/17/59. GRAZIANO said that he had just received a long-distance call from RAND on 10/17/59 and that RAND said that he and U. S. Consular Representative met with the subject and a Russian Diplomatic Representative at a Russian Police Station in Moscow, USSR on this date. RAND stated that the subject was in apparently good health and under no form of duress or restraint and the subject formally renounced his U. S. citizenship, stating he wished to remain in the Soviet Union inasmuch as he likes the Soviet system better than the American system.
