3. How will this affect the loperation? We are afraid that MOSEY will be suspected of participating in some sort of clandestine and that she was rather close to A in Erussels for an activities and that she was rather close to A in Erussel extended period of time; that her continuous efforts to recontact. _ A will most likely not go unnoticed; and that A may become suspected of having clandestine relationships with MOSBY, causing him to come under surveillance. Even if the MVD determines that this relationship is purely social, will still have a black mark on his record and possibly be prevented from ever going to the West again.
