1. Mr. McCarthy of IGNS informed me today that when he called Mr. Antens, District Director at Miani, Mr. Arens informed him that Bernie Weichardt had arranged for and had brought the subject to Miami, where he was given a hearing and re-paroled on si July 1999.

2. I informed Mr. Tom Flores of the above and he stated that he had just veceived information from Mr. Reichardt that the hearing had been given. I pointed out to Mr. Flores at that time since Mr. Cotter and Mr. Nice had gone to considerable trouble to arrange for the entry of the subject so that he would not have to be taken to jismi, that it would have been much better had the Central Office, of JANS known that this nearing was to be given so that Mr. McCarthy would not have to learn of it by a telephone call to Mr.

3. On 9 September 1959, Tom Florts stated in Caple 22776 contained the information that the subject's wife had applied for a visa at Mexico City and the U. S. Consul had requested an advisory opinion from Washington in State cable 573 dated 6 September 1959.

4. Mr. Spence of State Department Informed methe had the cable on his desk and he would request Agency checks immediately and he would keep me informed about the progress of the case.
