On 22 May Fetur IELREOV crount the news that Vasil TAZAROV had been arrosted on 19 May and on 26 May, his wife, Maria, had been arrosted. He also told them that one Stefan SIMPAROV, a lawyer, from Sofia had arrived in Plovdiv and wished to join the Trudovake in their flight to Greece. Petur DN NAC / saw some Security agents serveilling the lawyer and further contact was impossible.
- 12 From 26 May to 6 June the Trudovaks remained in cola Morila or other places in the vicinity and in wandering around the area their presence became known to the inhabitants.
- 13. On 7 June Boris PELTENOV advised them to go to Markovo and hide in Ivan NIKOLOV'S place where it would be easier to provide them with fool. That same evening they went to NIKOLOV's place and he explained to them that his brother. Petur, had been arrested, and they had decided to escape to over .

  The NIKOLOVS were to be joined by the brothers H.LTHOV, whose house had been placed under police surveillance. However, on 7 June Boris Politicov came to Gola Mogila and told the Trudovaks that his brother, fetur, did not consider the situation completely compromised and was reluctant to join the escape party.

With the help of a relative, Nikolina DOMAOVA, an old communist, Lazard, was promoted to MOD in the army.
  - 16. Subject states he never saw the Gorjani rebels, but he ofter heart of them and had listened to the Gorjani radio station broadcasts. On 23 May 1551 informant states he saw an aeroplans cruising in in the area of the village Ferdinandovo, Plovdiv, which was allegedly attacked by the Gorjanis.

    LAZAROV told the Trudovaks that the Gorjanis had three groups, one each in Plovdiv, Sliven and Sofis areas.
  - 17. In the village Belastica there were about 1250 inhabitants but only about 20 were communists. Informant did not knew of any anti-communist organization in the village.
  - 18. Informant did not know the brothers NIKOLOV previously. He regards them as sold nationalists, energetic and honost. He never suspected them of all latter with the State Security and believes they had ample opportunity to hand them over to the Militia if the NIKOLOVS were so inclined.
  - 19. Informant also did not know Petur and Peris PSLTEROV. He thinks they are both anti-communist and therough nationalists. According to informant, Fetur PELTEROV is the exuberant type, beasting and not very serious. Both PELTEROV blaned IAZAROV for all their trouble while they were in Bulgaria, but later in Orecce they defended him. The querrel between the NIKOLOVS and the PELTEROVS was caused by mutual suspicion, mostly with respect to IALEDV. The hardship and hunger endured during their flight to Greece added to the original misunderstanding.
- 20.00 Of the members of the underground organization, informant saw only Ivan Todorov STOINNOV, who instructed them in operating weapons, and Angel HUSTOZOV. HUSTOZOV left a solid and positive impression with informant
