The following information is being set forth in this section in order to protect the source from which the information was received:

PH 591-C* on 2/17/62 furnished the following information:

ANGELO BRUNO, Philadelphia, Pa., stated that he had contacted Congressman FRANCIS E. WALTER, Easton, Pa., and asked him to talk to the subject. At first, WALTER was reluctant to do so, but when advised that BUFALINO had been one of those attending the Apalachin meeting, WALTER agreed to do so because he said that he knew that those who had attended this meeting did not talk. The subject was taken by BRUNO to talk to Congressman WALTER. During this meeting WALTER indicated a knowledge of the subject's immigration problem. He asked BUFALINO what type of business he was in, and was told that he was in the clothing business. asked him if he could open a factory in his congressional district because if he did, he (WALTER) could do him a lot of good with government contracts and the like. WALTER was asked by BUFALINO if he wanted an interest in his business, and WALTER said he would think about this. During the meeting WALTER was reported to have agreed to see what he could do about helping BUFALINO and his problems with the Immigration Service. However, since this meeting, there has been a rift

between ANGELO BRUNO and Congressman WALTER, and WALTER now refuses to see or even talk to BRUNO on the telephone. The status of BRUNO's case with Congressman WALTER is not known.

PH 623-C* advised that during the week of 2/10/62, ANGELO BRUNO, Philadelphia, Pa., had been in contact with the subject, RUSSELL A. BUFALINO.
