1. The following information regarding American and possible American personnel has been received from the British 309th Field Security Section, BERLIN:

a) HUTTO, Raymond H. Serial No. RA53117942, US Army, AWOL 28 June 1954

Source met the a/n as a work mate at the VEB-ROBUR-Kraftfahrzeugwerk (formerly the Phaenom-Werk), who are engaged in the building of small vehicles for the East German Army, also busses and cars. It is not known how long HUTTO has been working at this factory, but it is believed to be some years. HUTTO, who is a negro, is believed to be a former student and a native of Georgia, USA. He is reputed to be very fond of women, but is not believed to be contemplating marriage with any of his cohabitants. He appears to be on extremely good terms with the local populace, from whom he often borrows money and cigarettes in spite of his earning approximately 400 E/Marks per month. His financial instability is due to his many female committments. It is considered possible that he would return to the West, but is afraid of the action that will be taken against him by the US authorities, he does, in fact, believe that he will be hanged upon his return. He was last seen by source on 14 July 1957.

b) AVENT, Willie, Serial No. RA 53164551. US Army. AWOL 8 March 1956

Source gave a brief description of the a/n and later positively identified him from photographs. He was last seen in the Clubhouse, BAUTZEN in March/April 1957. He is believed to be living in Taschenberg 2. Source had little contact with the a/n whom he only knew by sight.

c) ADELANI, fnu

Source has heard of this person, who is of negroid extraction and he is believed to be studying in DRESDEN (ROZ).
