Re your memorandum #15,237 dated May 24, 1972, in response to my memorandum dated May 15, 1972. (u)

Again, under the "Freedom of Information Act", Attorney Bernard Fensterwald, Jr., of Washington, D. C., has requested "twenty photographs of possible white male Americans who had been in Mexico City during September and October, 1963" which were shown on February 20, 1964 to Mexican resident Pedro Gutierrez Valencia in an effort to determine if Gutierrez might identify any of these unknown individuals as the person he previously identified as Oswald, whom he claimed to have observed at the Cuban Embassy, Mexico City, on October 1, 1963. (u)

These twenty photos were received from your office on February 19, 1964 and all were described as possible Americans who had visited the Cuban Embassy during September and October, 1963. Gutierrez failed to identify any of them as of the person he had seen there on October 1, 1963 and whom he believed to be Oswald. Also furnished to this office with the aforementioned twenty photographs were the three photos (u)
