With respect to DAVIDSON, JOSEPH PAGAN, International Banking Division, First National Bank of Arizona, advised that on 4/26/66, he received a call from a person identifying himself as BILLY DAVIDSON and who said he was one of the original group desirous of selling the Dominican pesos. DAVIDSON asked if Dr. JAMES had been in contact with PAGAN recently, and when advised he had not, DAVIDSON said the group was to meet the following day and JAMES would call him in a few days. There was no explanation given PAGAN for the call, and nothing has been heard from these individuals since. Subsequently, Mrs. STEINERT advised that a 1965 Chrysler Imperial had driven Dr. JAMES to the motel, Arizona license HHE 885. This auto is registered to a CAROLE DAVIDSON, P. O. Box 153, Scottsdale, Arizona.
