Re Miami report of SA LEMAN L. STAFFORD, JR.,

Investigation conducted to date by all offices  
have disclosed that the Agrupacion Montecristi is relatively  
inactive as an Anti-Castro group.

On August 7, 1962, GAUDENCIO CASTRO SOLOZABAL,  
PSI - CUBA, who furnished reliable information in the past,  
advised SA LEMAN L. STAFFORD, JR. that the Agrupacion  
Montecristi is inactive at the present time. He said the  
Agrupacion Montecristi (AM) is not spending any funds in  
any Anti-Castro endeavor. The AM is waiting and watching  
for some assistance from the United States Government and  
approval from them to engage in some strong anti-Castro  
activity.

In view of the above, Miami will prepare a  
closing report on this organization within the near future.
