On 4/24/61, PCI BETTY PARENT advised SA WARREN C.  
deBRUEYS as follows:

She alleges she typed a letter for subject on  
4/21/61, which letter was directed to a Mr. W. PHILIP COX,  
1612 K Street, Washington, D. C. BETTY PARENT explained  
that this man is supposed to obtain large amphibious ducks  
for export to Germany for a man named JOHN KAFFKA, whom  
she described as a white man, middle aged, tall, and wears  
a big mustache. She was not aware of the ultimate purpose  
for the acquisition of these amphibious ducks. Inquiry was  
made of BETTY PARENT as to whether or not the address she  
gave did not reflect whether the K Street was in the Northwest,  
Southwest or Northeast, Southeast section of Washington, as it  
appears that this is an incomplete address.

BETTY PARENT also advised that on the past week end  
subject DALZELL attempted to persuade SERGIO ARCACHA SMITH,  
of the Frente Revolucionario Democrático (FRD) (Cuban  
Revolutionary front), to purchase two submarines which  
DALZELL alleges are tied up near Houma, Louisiana, as well as
