P. PRICE, 237 Pearl, Denver, Colorado. PRICE is a source of information and his identity should be protected.

The Bureau's attention is called to the paragraphs contained in the material that the "Minutemen" organization is now the object of an intensive investigation and that "Many (perhaps all) major FBI offices have received identical memos from Washington to investigate Minutemen activities in their areas."

It is assumed that the Kansas City Office has received through its sources copies of this material.
