Rerep SA LEMAN L. STAFFORD, JR. at Miami, 2/14/61.

On May 2, 1961, MM 726-S informed SA LEMAN L. STAFFORD, JR. that subject participated in the unsuccessful invasion of Cuba in April, 1961. (u)

Subject told informant he was given a boat and went in the invasion at Bahia de Cochinos. He claimed to have been responsible for the destruction of two CASTRO aircraft. (u)

MM 726-S further reported subject claimed that with air support, the invasion would have been a success. Subject claimed to have gone ashore in Cuba; the invaders had captured 96 CASTRO soldiers, then had to release them when the CASTRO planes fired on them. (u)

Subject told informant he saw no MIGs, only Sea Furies, T-33s, or B-26 aircraft of the Cuban Air Force. (u)

Subject also said that his yacht, the "Alisan," has a radio transmitter on it at present, and that this transmitter is being used to beam anti-CASTRO propaganda to Cuba. An individual named FNU PONS is reportedly maintaining the radio equipment. (u) NO LOCALITY

Miami is attempting to ascertain through CIA, Miami, if they have an operational interest in the "Alisan." (u)
