On February 14, 1965, klansman Paul Coone allegedly went by the residence of blansman Billy C. Morris in Bogalusa.

Morrie is heading a drive to got all klamemen in the Rogaluss area to join the National Rifle Association. Morrie said the reason for this is to got as many members in the Rogaluss area to support the NRA as the NRA is fighting against a pending bill in Congress relating to the obtaining of firearms by private citizens.

Information had recently been received from Arris Warner that Morris had all of the material needed to make hand groundes with the exception of the dumy grenades themselves.

According to Morris, he does not have such material, however, he could activate a dummy grenade by using regular gunpowder in the grenade, insert a dummy cap and fuse and seal the grenade opening. Thereafter the fuse would have to be lighted in order to activate the dummy cap. Morris said he did not have any dummy grenades on hand at his residence and none were observed but said that dummy hand grenades could be obtained at the Grescent Gun Shop in New Orleans, Louisiana. Morris allegedly displayed a "nigger shooter" (slingshot) and stated he had a fairly large amount of .45 caliber slugs which could be used in the operation of this slingshot.
