The indices of the New Orleans Office contain no information identifiable with L. ROSS or BEULAH F. MOORE whose names are set forth in the details of this report.

The files of the New Orleans Office contain the following information relative to HARRY E. HILL, Box 184, Oil City, Louisiana, who is mentioned in the details of this report:

This information indicates that HARRY E. HILL, JR., P.O. BOX 182, Mooringsport, Louisiana, directed a letter to the FBI in Shreveport informing that he was attempting to organize a group known as the "Peacemaker Organization" and that this would be a patriotic group. HILL indicated that as a result he had subscribed to the "Worker" for research purposes only and stated that he had been fighting communism for four years as a Christian anti-communist crusader. May, 1960, the New York Office furnished information that copies of the "Worker" were being sent to the "Peacemaker Organization: P.O. Box 182, Mooringsport, Louisiana. This file further reveals printed material regarding the "Peacemaker Organization: which was provided by the Dallas Office.
