The following information is supplemental to information furnished in letterhead memorandum of April 1, 1965.

On April 21, 1965, at Houston, Texas, William Lewis Seale furnished the following information:

Seale is employed by Montgomery Ward Company, Palm Center, 1510 Griggs Road, Houston, Texas. He is assigned to the Auto Service Repair Department and has been employed by that company at Houston since February 18, 1965. Prior to moving to Houston in November, 1964, Seale had been in the employ of Montgomery Ward Company, at Fort Worth, Texas. As of April 1, 1965, Seale has been residing at Houston at 5278 Perry Street, the residence of Mr. and Mrs. Cevero Garcia. Cevero Garcia and Seale both came originally from Port Arthur, Texas, and have known each other for many years. Garcia is employed by the City of Houston.

In approximately February or March, 1964, when he was residing in Fort Worth, Texas, Seale and a friend named Arthur Pollard made the acquaintance of a man in a lounge at Fort Worth. This person, who Seale recalls only by the name of Ray, claimed to be a member of the John Birch Society and also claimed that he was a friend of General Walker, U. S. Army, retired. The man named Ray stated he owned a farm near Midlothian, Texas. Seale recalled that Ray mentioned that he, Ray, had some dynamite but Seale could not furnish additional information pertaining to the location or amount of dynamite in the possession of Ray. Ray also told Seale that there was an underground movement in Dallas which was associated with General
