SOURCE, SOURCE EVALUATION, APPRAISAL OF CONTENT: Newspaperman with connections close to EZCURDIA (B). Appraisal of Content: 2.

1. Mario EZCURDIA, director of the leftist magazine Al Dia, ^{said} has stated that, as of February 1958, the publication would appear weekly. Al Dia ^{has been appearing published} twice a month previously. EZCURDIA said also that through the efforts of José Domingo LAVIN and Sergio NOVELO the magazine would receive more paid-government advertising ^{from the government.}
2. EZCURDIA ^{added} stated that as of 1 January 1958 the following persons, all Marxists, had been added to the staff of Al Dia:
