I. INTELLIGENCE HIGHLIGHTS

A. KUJUMP INTEL

1. MIAMI 8346, REPORTS ANGEL GARCIA LUGO WHO ARRIVED U.S. 27 NOV, REPORTED PLANS FOR UPRISING AGAINST GOC STARTING 1 DEC OR SHORTLY THEREAFTER. REVOLT WOULD START IN PINAR DEL RIO PROV, PROBABLY IN CORDILLEROS DE LOS ORGANOS MTS, AND WOULD BE AIMED AT PREVENTING IMPLEMENTATION NEW CUBAN DRAFT LAW. SOURCE HEARD OF PLANNED REVOLT FROM TWO SOURCES, ONE OF WHOM APPARENTLY MEMBER "EJERCITO DE LIBERACION".

B. WAVE INTEL

1. UFG-4159 (CABLE) ANCOG-3 REPORTS CHINESE FROM PEIPING LANDED CIENFUEGOS, LAS VILLAS PROVINCE AS OF 24 OCT. MOST CHINESE IN CUBA ARE FROM HONG KONG THUS DIFFICULTY FINDING INTERPRETERS FOR NEW ARRIVALS IS BEING EXPERIENCED.
