I. INTELLIGENCE HIGHLIGHTS

A. KUJUMP INTEL

1. MINT 10952, 11011 AND 11013 REPORTED REACTION BY PEOPLE OF HAVANA, TORONTO, CATAGUEY AND CAIBARIEN TO NEWS PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S DEATH WAS AS IF BOMB HAD EXPLODED CAUSING SHOCK AND GRIEF. COMMUNISTS REACTION APPEARED BE ONE OF REJOICING.

2. MINT 10975 REPORTED CHIEF OF INSTRUMENT MAINTENANCE DIVISION, CUBANA AIRLINES HAD DESCRIBED TEST EQUIPMENT RECEIVED FROM USSR FOR CHECKING OUT IL-14 AND IL-13 INSTRUMENTS. REFUGEE SAID NO INSTRUMENTS CATALOGS OR INSTRUCTION MANUALS WERE AVAILABLE FOR IL-14 OR IL-13.

3. MINT 11031 REPORTED RECEIPT SOC MEMORANDUM ON CRITICALLY NEEDED SUPPLIES SUCH AS INSULATION MATERIALS FOR GENERATORS AND ELECTRIC MOTOR REWINDING, TRANSMISSION BELTS, RAILROAD EQUIPMENT, AND VALVES.

1. UFG 4166 (CABLE) ANCHIT-1 REPORTS CUBANS WHO ATTEMPTED LAND IN CUBA FROM VESSEL REX WERE OBSERVED BY RADAR PRIOR LANDING ATTEMPT. 7 413-15 '6 WHICH TOOK PART IN INTERCEPTION LANDING PARTY ARRIVED AT SAN JULIAN AIR BASE ON MORNING OF INCIDENT. AFTER ENCOUNTER AIRCRAFT RETURNED TO UNIDENTIFIED BASES.

2. UFG 4161 (CABLE) ANGLATTO, REPORTS POSSIBILITY GWC WILL ESTABLISH COMMUNAL DINING HALLS IN RESTAURANTS. ALSO RUMORED FOOD RATION BOOKS WILL BE ABOLISHED IF DINING HALLS ORGANIZED.

3. UFG 4167 (CABLE) REPORTS COMMANDOS L PREPARED SAIL FOR STRIKE AGAINST CUBA AS SOON AS SEA CONDITIONS PERMIT.
