4. Investigation of LIEVOY Information

During this period LIEVOY provided operational data of interest in connection with the visit to Mexico of President Tito of Yugoslavia.

WIAI-6875 reported a contact by an English-speaking man with the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City. This was forwarded to Headquarters for further dissemination.

WIAI-674 reported a long distance call from Marie EUGOUST from Las Vegas who claimed to be a student working with the Cuban Embassy in Mexico. Further investigation was left to Headquarters.

WIAI-6615 reported contact between New York Times writer, Herbert MATHEWS and the Cuban Embassy in Mexico. No investigative action was taken by the Mexico Station.
