In view of the departure from Mexico of LITAMIL/9, who in the past has made most LIONION photo identifications, the Station feels that the bulk of the LIONION photographs should perhaps be quickly transmitted to JMWAVE for review by such assets as AMMUG/1 and AMNIP/1. As with previous transmittals of LIONION photographs to Headquarters, the pulse camera films would be processed only through the negative stage by the Station and printing would have to be done in PBPRIME.
