SUBJECT: JFK-Congressional Hearing

- 1. On 8 November, Steve Tilley, National Archives (NARA), advised me that Congressman Conyers' Subcommittee on Legislation and National Security will hold an open hearing on JFK on 17 November. The apparent purpose is to receive a status report from NARA on the processing of JFK assassination records. NARA is the only Executive Branch agency that has been invited to testify. Gerald Posner, Jim Lesar, and Robert Blakey are also scheduled to testify.
- 2. We are not aware that CIA has been asked to provide anything for the hearing.
