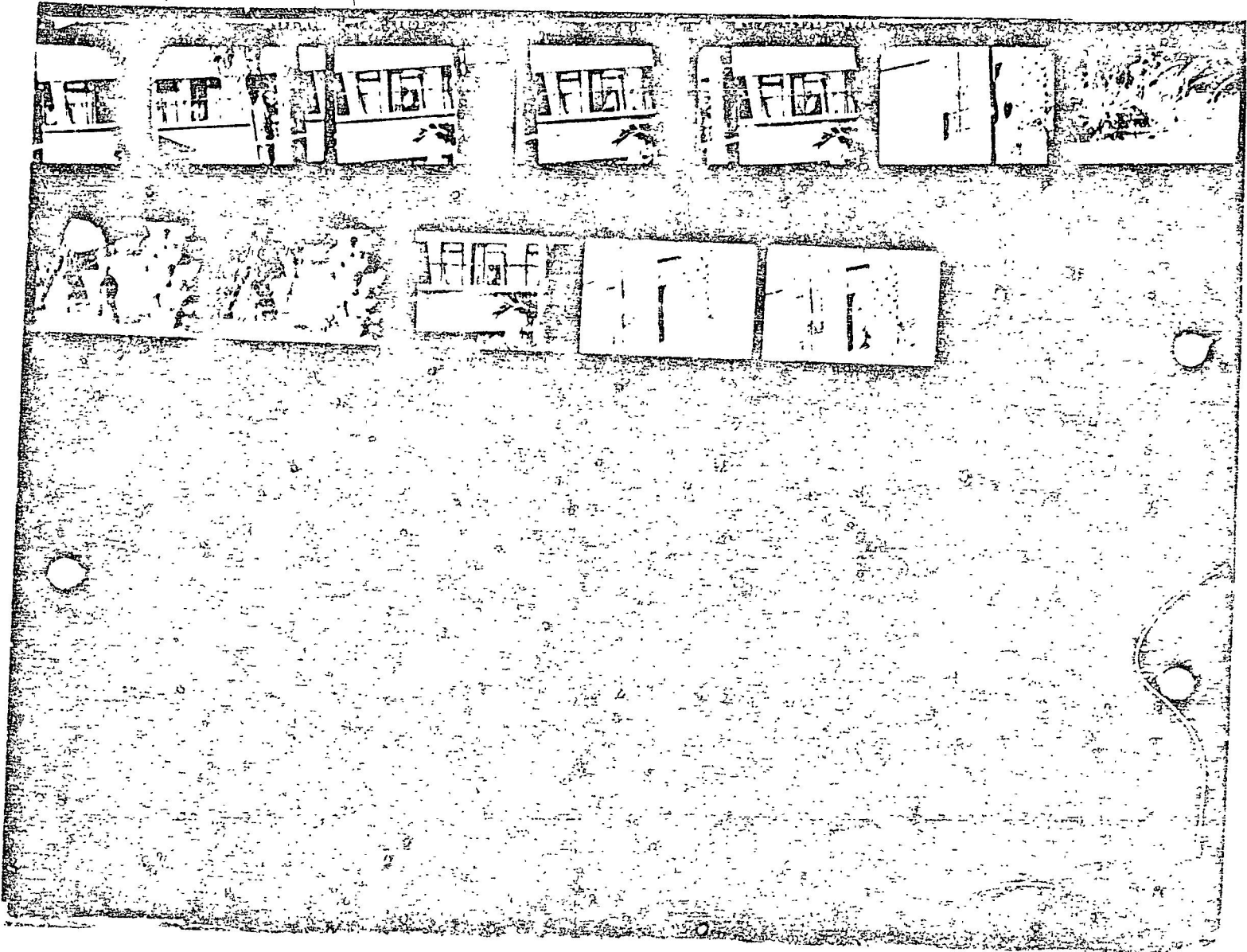
VIRGEN, Marzo 9, a las ocho de la mañana, una camioneta, color azul y mar-
