MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, CI/R&A

SUBJECT: Anatoly A. LOBANOV's Interest in a Defector

REFERENCE: ²² [ODCA] 12340, 18 August 1964

1. Reference reported that Costille had met LOBANOV at a Soviet Embassy reception in Copenhagen on 5 August 1964. During their brief conversation, LOBANOV referred to the defection of "one of our people." LOBANOV said he remembered the name as something like "GOLUBTSIN." Costille conjectured and we agreed that LOBANOV was fishing for information on AELADLE.
2. On second thought, LOBANOV might have been referring to the case of Aleksey Elizarovich GOLUB. GOLUB was a chemist who was travelling with a Soviet tourist group when he defected outright in The Hague on 7 October 1961. Note that this was only a few months before AELADLE's defection.
