- l. Reference reported that Costille had met IOBANOV at a Soviet Embassy reception in Copenhagen on 5 August 1964. During their brief conversation, IOBANOV referred to the defection of "one of our people." IOBANOV said he remembered the name as something like "COLUBTSIN." Costille conjectured and we agreed that IOBANOV was fishing for information on ADIADLE.
- 2. On second thought, IOBANOV might have been referring to the case of Aleksey Iliaranovich GOLUB. GOLUB was a chemist who was travelling with a Soviet tourist group when he defected outright in The Hague on 7 October 1961. Note that this was only a few months before AELADIE's defection.
