The following is an extract from a Memorandum of Conversation written by the Chief, FI/Departmental Coordination Group.

SUBJECT: Meeting with Army on 14 FEB 1962

This extract is forwarded ^{OG} for action, information, or comment. If additional information is desired, please call Mr. John Glennon, Extension 3251.

1. Mexico. Mr. ^{OG} Glennon asked Col. Doerflinger's permission for our Mexico City Station to use LIEUFF/1 as a cut-out in a Station operation. He said that the Station has stated that such use would not conflict with the Army's use of LIEUFF/1. Col. Doerflinger agreed to such use and commented that he had the impression that ~~Glennon~~ might be leaving Mexico for the U.S. at some not too distant future date.
