the sake of expediency (i.e., they wish to get rid of an albatross); others, however, genuinely think that Ray is fundamentally antagonistic to what they believe in. These people thus oppose him on principle, now that they have learned more about the details of his character and his program. In any event, Pazo seems perfectly willing to go along. The only trouble, so I am told, is that neither Pazo nor Beruff have any personal following inside Cuba. Justino Pérez does have a personal following there, but he favors Ray and not Pazo. Now, Barquín is very much interested in Delio García-Ochoa, the old "comandante" during the Castro rebellion against Batista, and now in jail in the Dominican Republic. Barquín feels (as do many others) that Delio might well serve as a cohesive force within the MRP, to pull together the "rightists" (Beruff and Pazo) and the "leftists" (Ray and Pérez), because everyone holds him in such high esteem. Of course, the only trouble is that Delio is not currently "available".

One of my Cuban friends, who is well-versed in affairs in Oriente Province, has informed me that the "colonos" and others there feel pretty much the same about the MRP situation as I have described above. Thus, the conflicts outside of Cuba within the MRP are mirrored inside Cuba, or at least are so mirrored inside Oriente Province.
